1 GNUmakefile

This chapter and its sections are markup collected from the GNUmakefile. It is an example how markup can appear in almost any file.

1.1 The FILES Variable

FILES lists the input files, processed in sequence.

- 1. Names matching *.m4 are preprocessed with m4, turning file.ext.m4 into file.ext.
- 2. Names matching *.txt are considered plain AsciiDoc.
- 3. All other extensions are scanned for AsciiDoc between delimiters.

The last file must have a <?lastpage?> processing instruction near the end.

1.2 The DOCUMENT_NAME Variable

DOCUMENT_NAME is the basename of the created files.

1.3 Targets

- 1. all: (default), create the PDF and HTML documents as \$(DOCUMENT_NAME).pdf and \$(DOCUMENT_NAME).html.
- 2. zip: create a ZIP file named \$ (DOCUMENT_NAME).zip for SAP.
- 3. clean: remove intermediate files and targets made.
