1 GNUmakefile

This chapter and its sections are markup collected from the `GNUmakefile`. It is an example how markup can appear in almost any file.

1.1 The FILES Variable

`FILES` lists the input files, processed in sequence.

1. Names matching `*.m4` are preprocessed with `m4`, turning `file.ext.m4` into `file.ext`.
2. Names matching `*.txt` are considered plain AsciiDoc.
3. All other extensions are scanned for AsciiDoc between delimiters.

The last file must have a `<?lastpage?>` processing instruction near the end.

1.2 The DOCUMENT_NAME Variable

`DOCUMENT_NAME` is the basename of the created files.

1.3 Targets

1. `all`: (default), create the PDF and HTML documents as `$(DOCUMENT_NAME).pdf` and `$(DOCUMENT_NAME).html`.
2. `zip`: create a ZIP file named `$(DOCUMENT_NAME).zip` for SAP.
3. `clean`: remove intermediate files and targets made.
